

TERRAE GLOSSARY AND GENERAL SETTING

GLOSSARY

Bordé (bore-day): The system by which when Genahs of different species marry can have children by proxy of a group of Genahs, called Bordé, who's sole existence is to carry or impregnate the higher-classed Genah of the appropriate species. Because Bordé are the lowest class anyone with enough money can demand their services.

Chigo (chy-go): The capital city of the kingdom near it's northern boarder.

Copper: A coin made of copper; the most commonly used coin in Normar.

Enandoplas (in-an-doe-plas): The name of a Duchy and a city about 300-miles south-southeast of Chigo. The current Duke of Enandoplas is Mikael Andago.

Genah (Gen-uh): The therianthropic peoples of Terrae.

Aurum(Are-um): A coin equal to 5 Luminim and is the most valuable common coin in Nomar.

Jipsee (Jip-see): A nomadic trading people often shunned.

Luminim (Loo-men-um): 1) A precious silver-white metal with a light weight but low strength compare to steel. 2) A coin of made of luminim; equal to about 100-copper or 5-silver.

Normar (nor-mar): The kingdom that Enandoplas is located in.

Ooman (oo-mahn): A legendary race to the Genah's. A largely furless primate usually 5' to 6' tall and 90-200-lbs with a large cranium housing a highly developed brain and with opposable thumbs.

Silver: A coin made of silver; equal to 20-copper or 1/5-luminim.

Terrae (tear-ree): The World (See **Setting** below)

SETTING

A world similar to late in Europe's medieval period. The classes consist of: royalty, nobility, middle-class, lower-class or peasants and Bordé. The peoples are called Genahs which are detailed elsewhere but have both human and animal physical features. The primary region detailed is largely forests, prairies and farms bound to the east by the low Apalch Mountains and the west by the much higher Rock Mountains. Genah cities are built near, and take their names from, the Urbs Prohibitus — Forbidden Cities.
